Frequency of Reviews: Every three (3) years



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All board authority delegated to employees, officers, or body of the college (as defined by the Post-secondary Learning Act) is delegated through the President and CEO. All authority and accountability of these groups is considered to be the authority and accountability of the President and CEO.

1. The board will direct the President and CEO to achieve specified results through the establishment of Ends policies. The board will limit the latitude the President and CEO may exercise in practices, methods, conduct and other means to the Ends through establishment of Executive Limitations policies.
2. The President and CEO, using any reasonable interpretation of the board's Ends and Executive Limitations policies, is authorized to establish all procedures, make all decisions, take all actions, establish all practices and develop all activities.
3. The board may change its Ends and Executive Limitations policies, thereby shifting the boundary between board and President and CEO domains. By so doing, the board changes the latitude of choice given to the President and CEO; however, as long as any particular delegation is in place, the board and its members will respect and support the President and CEO's choices. The board may still obtain information in the delegated areas.
4. Only decisions of the board acting as a body are binding upon the President and CEO.
  - a) Except in rare instances when the board has specifically authorized such exercise of authority.
5. The President and CEO can refuse individual board members' requests that are excessive or disruptive.
6. The President and CEO may request that the board invite board members to become non-voting members of administrative committees of the college to provide their input as individuals based on their experience and their individual expertise in accordance with policy GP-6 Board Committee Structure.
