

BOARD OF GOVERNORS – Executive Limitations

Policy #: **EL 13 General Academic Council**

Frequency of Reviews: Every three (3) years



The *Post-secondary Learning Act* requires that there be an academic council for Medicine Hat College, and gives the Board of Governors (the “board”) responsibility for certain aspects of the organization and operation of the academic council.

Accordingly, the President and CEO shall not:

1. Operate without an academic council that complies with the requirements of the *Post-secondary Learning Act*.
2. Fail to develop guidelines for approval of the board that stipulate the term of service and conditions of service, if any, for members of the academic council.
3. Fail to come to an agreement, with the academic staff association and the students’ association as to the number of members to be elected or appointed by each of the academic staff association, the students’ association, and the board, up to the maximum limits specified by the *Post-secondary Learning Act*.
4. Fail to recommend to the board members and/or positions to be appointed by the board (excluding the President and CEO).
