To Whom It May Concern:

Students registered in the Environmental Reclamation Technician program have a practicum component that is for credit, and is integral to completion of their program of study. The practicum does not exceed more than 50% of the total program of study.

As part of the program, students must complete one (1) work term. This term requires a minimum of 220 hours. This work term can be completed in spring semester of the students' first year or at the end of their program following their capstone courses. Students are scheduled to complete their program at the end of the spring semester of their second year.

Duties may include, but are not limited to internships, research or projects related to environmental science or environmental land reclamation.

We are asking that a co-op work permit be granted to the applicant, registered in our program, in order to fulfill program requirements as outlined in our academic calendar.
