To Whom It May Concern:

Students registered in the Bachelor of Nursing program have a practicum component that is for credit, and is integral to completion of their program of study. The practicum does not exceed more than 50% of the total program of study.

As part of the program, students must complete two (2) work terms in their second year. These terms are completed in Fall and Winter semesters for a total of 247 hours each. For years 3 and 4 students are enrolled with University of Calgary.

These work terms will provide students the opportunity to integrate and apply theoretic knowledge in nursing practice settings; moreover develop skills and competencies of groups, communities and populations.

We are asking that a co-op work permit be granted to the applicant, registered in our program, in order to fulfill program requirements as outlined in our academic calendar.
