Students registered in the Social Work program have a practicum component that is for credit, and is integral to completion of their program of study. The practicum does not exceed more than 50% of the total program of study.

As part of the program, students must complete two work terms. These terms are completed in the fall and winter semesters (September to April) in the second year, for a total of 714 hours. Students are scheduled to complete their program at the end of their winter term of their second year.

Duties may include, but are not limited to, offering services to clients and participating in agency programs.

We are asking that a co-op work permit be granted to the applicant, registered in our program, in order to fulfill program requirements as outlined in our academic calendar.
