

Decision Tree for Student with illness

Prior to coming on campus:

[REVIEW THE DAILY CHECKLIST](#)

If you answer **YES** to any of the questions, you must **NOT COME** to campus

If you have CORE SYMPTOMS

- Fever, runny nose, cough
- Sore throat, difficulty breathing
- Loss of taste or smell

Self-isolate, minimize contact with others, it is recommended to complete the [AHS Self-Assessment*](#) for consideration of a covid test. Notify your instructor and ask for direction with academic success in the course.

NOTE: IF NOT TESTED
Legal requirement to isolate for a minimum of 10 days from the onset of symptoms or until symptoms resolve, whichever is longer. Update instructor.

If you have OTHER SYMPTOMS

- Chills,
- Headache, stuffy nose
- Painful swallowing, conjunctivitis
- Muscle/Joint aches, feeling unwell
- Gastrointestinal symptoms

Stay home and minimize contact with others. It is recommended to complete the [AHS Self-Assessment](#) for consideration of a covid test. Notify instructor and ask for direction with academic success in course.

NOTE: IF NOT TESTED

Remain off campus and limit contact with others until symptoms have resolved. Update instructor.

TESTED

Positive Test

Follow AHS direction and update your instructor

Negative Test

You can return to campus once symptoms have resolve. Update your instructor.

If you **DO NOT HAVE SYMPTOMS** but have been notified that you are a close contact of a positive case of COVID-19:

- Monitor self for symptoms for 14 days
- Avoid crowded public places if not fully immunized
