



## **VACCINATION DECLARATION STATEMENT** **updated Sept. 20, 2021**

**By entering Medicine Hat College facilities between Sept. 20 and Oct. 4, 2021, you are affirmatively declaring that you have proof of at least one approved COVID-19 vaccination on or before Sept. 20, 2021.**

**A negative result of a third party rapid test taken within the 72 hours prior to your visit is also acceptable.**

**You also understand that you may be asked to provide proof of vaccination or a negative test result on demand.**

### **Vaccination Declaration**

Medicine Hat College has implemented this declaration to ensure the health and safety of our campus community. You are declaring your status as “vaccinated” or “proof of negative test” by entering the campus.

“**Vaccinated**” means you have received an approved COVID-19 vaccine.

“**Proof of negative test**” means that you have proof of a privately-paid negative PCR or rapid test taken within the 72 hours prior to your visit.

### **Integrity**

Employees and students are expected to act with integrity in the course of their employment and studies. By entering campus, you are certifying the status you declare is accurate and true.

If you are on campus, the college may ask you to verify your vaccination status. Verification will require you to provide proof of your declaration (e.g. presenting your immunization record or proof of negative test) upon request.

It is a serious breach to be untruthful about your vaccination status. Anyone found to be providing false information may be subject to discipline through college policy. For employees, the Code of Conduct policy applies. For students, the Non-Academic Misconduct policy applies.
