**Program Notes:**

- To successfully complete the program you must:
  - Successfully pass both practicums;
  - Attain an overall GPA of at least 2.0;
  - Complete all courses with no grades below C-.
  
- You should be aware that under the Protection for Persons in Care Act (January, 1998) you will be required to provide a current Police Information Check with Vulnerable Sector Search as well as an Alberta Children’s Services Intervention Record Check to the practicum placement supervisors prior to starting placements. A current First Aid certificate and Health Immunization Record will be required in practicum placements.
  
- Please note that if you are currently working in a school as an Education Assistant it may be possible to use your current experience as credit towards one of the practicum courses. Please ask the Program Coordinator at Red Deer College about a Prior Learning Assessment Recognition. All Practicums must be completed through Red Deer College.
