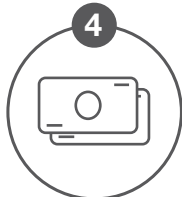

MHC partners with BorderPass (borderpass.ca) to offer students access to its premium Canadian immigration services at no cost. The BorderPass platform provides management of your study permit application and access to Canadian immigration lawyers.

If you are from a country with a high rate of study permit refusals, it is mandatory to work with MHC's partner, BorderPass, to submit your study permit application.
