Do I need a study permit?

Most students require a study permit to pursue post-secondary education in Canada. You can apply for a study permit after you are admitted into a program at MHC. It is wise to explore application details outlined by the Government of Canada early, as requirements (which may include biometrics) vary by country. How much money will I need to support myself in my studies?

To obtain a study permit, you must prove to the Government of Canada (GoC) that you can support yourself while in Canada without the need to work. The table below shows amounts required by GoC to support yourself as well as family members (if applicable). Please note that the actual living costs may be more or less than this amount. You must also demonstrate that you have enough additional funds to cover full tuition fees for the first year of your program. Working in Canada

International students who are enrolled full-time can work part-time while attending MHC if their study permit indicates. Some students, including those conditionally admitted or enrolled in General Studies, are not permitted to work, or have restrictions.

MHC programs are designed to help you launch a meaningful and successful career. To support those who wish to start that journey in Canada, the Canadian Post-Graduation Work Permit Program (PGWPP) is available to MHC program graduates.
