



DIRECTIONS FOR COMPLETING IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

Immunization requirements are set out in the Medicine Hat College Academic Calendar and are pre-program requirements. Immunization completion takes time in some cases.

The following documents are **required** by our Immunization Officer to complete your immunization review:

➤ **Alberta Health Services Client Immunization Record (Immunization Record).**

If other than Alberta or from another country:

1. Request your immunization history from your provincial public health agency or from country of origin.
2. Present your immunization documents to the Medicine Hat public health office for review and verification. Identify yourself as a Post-Secondary Health Care Student.
3. Book an appointment with a public health nurse to complete a Post-Secondary Health Care Student Assessment.
4. After your appointment with public health, please request your **AHS Client Immunization Record**. Visit [Medicine Hat Community Health Services](#) for contact information.

➤ **If applicable and as indicated by the Public Health Nurse:**

- Documentation of laboratory evidence of **Hepatitis B** immunity. This can be a letter/email from public health stating you have previous documented immunity (according to NetCare) or your Hep B lab result.
 - Documentation of laboratory evidence of **Varicella** immunity. This can be a letter/email from public health stating you have previous documented immunity (according to NetCare) or your varicella lab result.
 - Written confirmation from Public Health Nurse/physician that proper Tuberculosis follow up has been completed **after a positive/significant Tuberculosis Skin Test result** (TST reading of >10 mm).
- ✓ Email these documents to Immunizations@mhc.ab.ca **as soon as completed** but no later than June 30th, 2023.
- ✓ After your documents have been reviewed, you will be notified by email if any immunizations/test are required.
- ✓ If immunizations are incomplete, please submit confirmation date for completion of outstanding vaccines/tests.
